During opening assembly (school wide) every sponsor has the opportunity to talk about their organization. Give members a membership packet and during recruitment time give out things such as prizes, membership cards, locker magnets. Host a social event after school such as a pizza party for duespaid members Membership Dues: High School--\$6.00 for nationals and \$3.00 for state Middle Level--\$4.00 for nationals and \$2.00 for state
